- Operational challenges for emergency response and recovery

- Abstract should be sent by email to the NERIS Secretary sec@eu-neris.net
- Abstract submission deadline: December 31, 2017.
- Abstracts should be submitted in English.
- Abstract length: 1 page maximum.
- Electronic submission using the appropriate form (available on the NERIS Website) is compulsory.
- Programme Committee will select a limited number of abstract for oral and poster presentations. Authors will receive notification of acceptance by February 28, 2018.

Instructions for the 'NERIS Young Scientist Award'
