1. List of actions

CONCERT

1. WP2-WP3 – NERIS activities

a) Evolution of SRA and preparation of the Roadmap

- ⇒ Prepare the framework of the new version of the NERIS SRA and share with the NERIS MB and the R&D Committee (**J. Camps**)
- ⇒ Organize a meeting with the NERIS R&D and possibly jointly with NERIS MB in January (Brussels) dedicated to the elaboration of the NERIS Roadmap (**J. Camps**)

b) Interaction with SSH SRA

- ⇒ Organize a meeting as soon as possible with the leader of the SSH SRA to interact with them and clarify what is meaningful for them (participants from NERIS: E. Gallego, T. Duranova, T. Schneider). (**M. Maître**)

c) CONCERT Roadmap

- ⇒ Share the CONCERT Roadmap methodology with the NERIS MB and the R&D Committee (**T. Schneider**)
- ⇒ Write a first draft of the two reference societal scenarios for the joint CONCERT Roadmap on which NERIS is leader (by the end of October)
 - Facing the consequences of a radiological terrorist act (**W. Raskob**)
 - Facing the consequences of a major nuclear accident (**J. Camps**)

2. WP5

- ⇒ Wait the results of the first CONCERT Call before starting the identification of the potential NERIS stakeholders who could be involved in the WP 5.2 Stakeholder Group.

NERIS Workshop 2017 – Lisbon

- 5 sessions will be organized for the next NERIS Workshop:
 - Impact assessments
 - Countermeasure strategies and decision support
 - Emergency and recovery framework
 - Uncertainty handling
 - Stakeholder involvement and engagement
- The sessions will be divided between Thursday 18th May (all day long) and Friday 19th May (Morning)
- Working Group meetings could easily be organised on Friday 18th May (early afternoon)
- Participation of stakeholders for input to NERIS SRA or NERIS Roadmap could be possible (money from CONCERT available)
- Call for travel Grants could also be envisaged for junior scientists
- The NERIS General Assembly will be organised on Wednesday 17 May afternoon in Lisbon
- ⇒ Prepare the material (announcement, call for abstracts) and share it with the local organizers: IST and APA. **(M.Maître)**
- ⇒ Send an e-mail to all the NERIS supporting organizations informing that the Call for travel Grants is available for young scientists to attend NERIS Workshop 2017 **(M.Maître)**

EAN & NERIS Workshop 2017 – Lisbon

- 4 sessions will be organized for the joint EAN & NERIS Workshop:
 - Optimization/ intervention at high level organization (setting the scene)
 - Arrangement in emergency preparedness
 - First response
 - The (early) post-accident phase
- Around 10 – 20 NERIS members are expected for this EAN-NERIS Workshop.

Working Groups

1. WG ICRP

- A presentation of the new ICRP publication on « Application of the Commission's Recommendations for the Protection of People in the Event of a Nuclear Accident – Update of Publications 109 and 111 » could be envisaged for the next NERIS Workshop in Lisbon (2017)
- Some presentations or meetings could also be organized during the next ICRP symposium in 2017.

2. WG Local Stakeholder

- ⇒ Put the final NERIS TP workshop conclusions on the NERIS Website (**D. Oughton and M. Maître**)

3. WG CONGOO

- ⇒ Open an available section on the NERIS Website where WG CONGOO members would be able to upload the different reports produced by the national panels within PREPARE project. (**M. Maître**)
- ⇒ Create a WG CONGOO members forum. This can be done in the Analytical Platform. (**S. Charron, E. Gallego and W. Raskob**)

4. WG Information, Participation and Communication (WG IPC)

- All WG IPC members will have access to the analytical platform.
- A forum will be established with opening discussions on different topics:
 - Information and participation of the public
 - Disseminate and use the Analytical Platform (AP)
 - Interaction and exchange of experience between experts
 - Elements, tools or processes that can facilitate the EPR of local stakeholders
- Leaflets with the key messages from PREPARE WP6 and WP3 will be created.
- ⇒ NERIS could support the edition of the leaflets but the message that will be endorsed by NERIS need to be clear. Budget has to be identified for the publication of the leaflets.
- ⇒ Start compiling list of potential target NERIS stakeholders. (**M. Maître**)
- ⇒ Create a dedicated section to the WG IPC in the NERIS Website with relevant deliverables from previous projects (EURANOS; NERIS-TP; PREPARE) and with links of relevant deliverables and publications from related projects (EAGLE, Fukushima dialogues). (**M. Maître**)

5. Evaluation of the NERIS Working Groups

- Regarding the next General Assembly, it might be interesting to ask the supporting organizations to review and evaluate the Working Groups activities.
- ⇒ A questionnaire will be sent to the supporting organizations early 2017. **(M. Maître)**

International cooperations

- ⇒ Organize a meeting with ISPRA **(S. Andronopoulos)**
- ⇒ Sign the common letter of RP Platforms about the collaboration with NUGENIA. **(T. Schneider)**
- ⇒ Organize a technical expert meeting between NERIS and NUGENIA (SARNET WG) with MM. Brechignac and Van-Dorsselaere from IRSN. **(T. Schneider)**

- ⇒ Prepare and share with the NERIS MB a short report presenting recent and upcoming activities of NERIS relevant to the mandate of ICRP **(Thierry Schneider)**
