Objectives of the Workshop

The NERIS Workshop 2020 will focus on "Operational and research achievements and needs to further strengthen preparedness in emergency management, recovery and response" as well as common topics with international organisations and Radiation Protection Platforms.

This will be an opportunity to **discuss and exchange views** with NERIS Members, international organisations and European research communities on research developments and priorities for the European NERIS Platform.

The Workshop will take place on 27-29th May 2020 and the 11th General Assembly will take place on 27 May morning (9.30 to 12.00).

Venue

The Workshop will take place in Barcelona, Spain, at Palau Macaya. It is one of the Catalan Modernism buildings designed by architect Josep Puig i Cadafalch in 1901. Nowadays the palace is owned by La Caixa and is used for exhibitions and workshops. There is also an exhibit about the palace itself and the Catalan Modernism movement.


Main topics selected

As accommodation in Barcelona is in high demand in May, we advise to book rooms as soon as possible. We recommend the chain of hotels H10.





NERIS Young Scientist award

The NERIS Platform sets up again the 'NERIS Young Scientist Award', to promote young people whose professional or scientific works have been noted for their quality and originality.

To compete for this award, candidates are required to:

- be under 35 years old by May 2020;
- be the main author of the paper presented;
- mention on the abstract submission that they wish to compete for the 'NERIS Young Scientist Award'.

The award winner will be selected according to criteria established by the Programme Committee. The award will be announced and presented at the end of the 6th NERIS Workshop, and will consist of a diploma and a free registration to the next NERIS Workshop.
